## EASING OF WATERING RESTRICTIONS

New <u>year-round</u> watering schedule for automatic sprinklers:

Odd-Numbered Homes – MONDAY & THURSDAY

Even-Numbered Homes – TUESDAY & FRIDAY

Between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.

\*\*Watering with handheld hoses is allowed daily before 9:00 a.m. and after 5:00 p.m.\*\*

The conditions of the Water Management Act Permits issued to the Town of Foxborough by the Massachusetts DEP (Permit #9P2427099.01) require Foxborough to implement the following mandatory water restrictions on outdoor water use:

Non-essential outdoor water use is allowed after 5 PM through to 9 AM daily. Examples of **nonessential** outdoor water uses include:

- Irrigation of lawns via sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems;
- Washing of vehicles other than by means of a commercial car wash, except as necessary for operator safety, and
- Washing of exterior building surfaces, parking lots, driveways or sidewalks, except as necessary to apply paint, preservatives, stucco, pavement or cement.

The Water Department continues its rebate program for residential users who replace high flow toilets and washing machines with new lower flow models. Water-saving devices, such as low flow showerheads and aerators, are available from the Water Department. Please contact the Water Department at (508) 543-1209 for further details.

The Board of Water and Sewer Commissioners would like to thank all Foxborough residents for their remarkable sense of community and continued cooperation with these restrictions. Your efforts allowed our water supply to remain at safe levels.
